Springfield College is known worldwide as the “Birthplace of Basketball”, a game created by faculty member James Naismith in 1891.

Built in 2004, this dormitory building, housing 204 senior students, is known as “The Suites”. The building is comprised of 47 apartments with 4 to 6 students living in each apartment.

Strescon furnished 56,000 sf of 8” thick Strescon hollowcore plank. All of this plank, sitting on masonry walls was erected and grouted in just under 10 weeks.
